TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR INVITING TENDER OF GOODS

Bidders Qualification

1. The concerned supplier is expected to have adequate knowledge in understanding all the technical criteria and ability to fulfil those in clear terms given in the indent. The supplier must be in a position to bring all the indented items from authentic foreign source (known to be principal). He should be able to ensure that the source/principal is either to be internationally recognized manufacturer (having distinct website, fax and e-mail address) or agent of the respective manufacturer (having clear existence in the manufacturer website, own fax and e-mail address) or sub- agent of the respective agent (at list having fax and e-mail address).

Certificate/Document of the Authentication

2. Manufacturer authorization letter must be submitted in Original. The name and position held by each person signing the authorization must be typed or printed below the signature. Scanning paper, E-mail copy, Fax copy & Scanning Signature of manufacturer authorization will not be accepted.

3. The concerned supplier must provide following original certificate(s)/ documents(s) as applicable with the quotation and during delivery of items as regard to the genuineness of source and item(s) in order to establish chain of links from the original source to supply items:

- a. Certificate by the manufacturer in favour of the supplier/ local agent (in case of manufacturer as principal). or
- b. Two certificate one by the manufacturer to authorized agent and the other by the authorized agent to supplier/local agent (in case of authorized agent as principal).

Warranty/Guarantee

4. The supplier must ensure that all items are genuine and brand new. The supplier must provide warranty for at least for 01 (one) year from the date of acceptance of the item(s) after satisfactory inspection, test trial etc as applicable. If any defect / discrepancy of any item arise within the period of warranty, the specific period from the date of notification of the defect /discrepancy to the supplier up to the date of rectification of defect/ resolve of discrepancy will have to be deducted from the warranty period for that particular item(s).

5. If any defect/discrepancy arises, within warranty period, then the respective item(s) is/ are to be replaced free of cost including freight within 03 (three) months from the date of notification of the same to the supplier. In this regard, the supplier must furnish an undertaking with the offer by stating, "I do hereby assure that we take the liability to replace all spare parts/items(s) free of cost including freight within three months from the date of notification about the defect/ discrepancy of the spare parts / item(s) by the buyer, if it occurs within the period of warranty".

Essential Information

6. The bidder must mention its full name and address along with the chain of concerned source(s) i.e. manufacturer, agent and sub-agent with the offer as applicable from whom it has to collect certificate(s)/document(s) as per para-2.

7. If the quoted part / pattern no of item(s) is /are dissimilar from the indented one because of recent modification or any other technical reason, then the supplier must provide an original certificate from manufacturer in favour of substitute and adequate information/ instruction in this regard, if so necessary. The offered spare shall perfectly match with the said model of the equipment; but if does not match, it will have to be replaced free of cost including freight charge.

Validity and Delivery

8. Items (s) is/are to be delivered within the stipulated time mentioned in contract. However, the duration may be re-considered in special circumstances.
