1. US2 aircraft is a specialized use for fire extinguishers and disaster trouble. At present, this type of aircraft is used by Japan Maritime Self Defence Force. In the context of Bangladesh, a discussion session on this type of aircraft's utility was held between Security Advisor of Hon'ble Prime Ministers and Japan delegation. During Bi-lateral meeting between Principal Staff Officer, Armed Forces Division and Director General, Ministry of Defence, Japan this issue was also discussed. Government of Japan invited a delegation from Bangladesh for sharing the information of US2 Maritime Search and Rescue aircraft.
